

Family: Vanderhoof, Albert (s1785-?)

Albert¹ Vanderhoof, parentage unknown, was born say 1785, NY. He married **Nancy (---)**, b. NY.

Children of Albert¹ and Nancy (---) Vanderhoof (probably incomplete):

- i. **Albert² Vanderhoof** b. 2 Apr 1815 New York City, New York, NY.

Notes

There is an Albert Vanderhoof, shoemaker, living at 33 Pike St 7th Ward in 1815 which could be the same person as this Albert.^[1]

Also, a New York newspaper article in 1802 states "...Also left the service of the Subscriber, on the first instant, another apprentice to the same trade [shoemaking], named ALBERT VANDERHOOF, aged about 18 years, about 5 feet high, and of a fair complexion, light brown hair cut short, holes in his ears, and a scar on his right knee. Had on when he went away, a jean coatee and nankeen trousers, spotted velvet vest and black hat... PETER AMERMAN"^[2]

This Albert would have been born ca. 1784.

Family: Vanderhoof, Albert (1815-1891)

Albert² Vanderhoof, (Albert¹), son of Albert¹ and Nancy (---) Vanderhoof was born 2 Apr 1815 in New York City, New York, NY and died 7 Feb 1891, Winthrop, Suffolk, MA of paralytic shock.^[1]

He married **Mary Ann Lynch**, daughter of --- and Ann (Watson) Lynch. She was born 9 May 1817 in Paterson, Passaic, NJ and died 22 Mar 1901 in Everett, Middlesex, MA of influenza/senility.^[2] They are buried in Woodlawn Cemetery, Everett, MA.

Family: Vanderhoof, Albert (1853-1925)

Albert³ Vanderhoof, (Albert², Albert¹), son of Albert² and Mary Ann (Lynch) Vanderhoof was born 26 Feb 1853 in Boston, Suffolk, MA and died 11 Dec 1925, Concord, Middlesex, MA^[1].

He married 20 Sep 1877, Boston, MA, **Clarabelle Prior**, daughter Waterman Keen and Lydia Ann (Messer) Prior.^[2] She was born 27 Dec 1855 in Kittery, York, ME and died 16 Jul 1945 in Concord, Middlesex, MA^[3]. They are buried in Sleepy Hollow Cemetery, Concord, MA.

Albert was the founder of Vanderhoof Hardware, Main Street Concord, MA which is still family owned and operated today.

Frank Albert⁴ Vanderhoof, (Albert³, Albert², Albert¹), son of Albert³ and Clarabelle (Prior) Vanderhoof was born 2 May, 1883 in Boston, Suffolk, MA and died 6 Jul 1956 in Dover-Foxcroft, Piscataquis, ME^[1].

He married 5 Aug 1911, Acton, Middlesex, MA, **Laura Isabel Whitney**, daughter Henry Martin and Cora (Fiske) Whitney.^[2] She was born 17 Feb 1889 in Concord, Middlesex, MA and died 21 Dec 1948 in Concord, Middlesex, MA^[3]. They are buried in Sleepy Hollow Cemetery, Concord, MA.
